- Perform 280 unduplicated tobacco and e-cigs retailers compliance checks in per month and report violations to local authorities.
- Educate retailers on the most current tobacco laws as they pertain to minor access
- Initiate follow-up compliance visits with all tobacco retailers who have been cited for tobacco-related violations and provide informational materials regarding Texas Tobacco Laws.
- Conduct any additional tobacco-specific prevention activities as requested to support the goals of the PRC Tobacco Prevention Core.
- Participate in conference calls and webinars as scheduled by provider.
- Attend Annual Prevention Provider Meeting.
- Complete all required training for an opportunity for growth and development.
